- 1. Lay out four (4) corner fittings, two (2) tee fittings and six (6) (White 9'4") spreader pipes, and form perimeter frame. Assemble and insert pins.
- 2. Put one (1) (White 9'4") spreader pipe, and two (2) 3-way crown fittings into center of the frame. Slide two (2) adjustable slide fittings to center of the spreader pipe.
- 3. On one end, insert one (1) (Yellow 6'10") hip rafter into corner fitting and pin. Then insert opposite end of hip rafter into 3 way crown fitting and pin. Insert one end of another hip rafter into same 3 way crown fitting and pin. Then insert the opposite end into corner fitting and pin.
- 4. Insert one end of center spreader into the assembled 3 way crown fitting and pin.
- 5. Insert one end of side rafter (Red 4'11") into side tee fitting and pin. Insert opposite end into the slide fitting on center spreader and pin. Repeat on opposite side.
- 6. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to complete remaining end of frame.
- 7. Place canopy over frame and pull tight. Secure canopy to frame with buckle straps, tightening corner buckles first.
- 8. Raise one side of canopy; insert leg pipes (Black 7'8") into the corner and tee fittings and pin.
- 9. Raise opposite side of the canopy and install remaining legs.
- 10. The canopy and frame can now be tied down. Caution; tie down only at corner or tee fittings. Do not tie to spreader pipe as they may bend.
