D15X30

- Lay out four (4) corner fittings, two (2) tee fittings, and six (6) (red 14'4") spreader pipe and form perimeter frame. Assemble and insert 16p nails.
- Put one (1) (red 14'4") spreader pipe and two (2)3way crown fittings into center of frame. Slide two (2)adjustable slide fittings to center of the spreader pipe.
- 3. On one end, insert one (1) (green 10'6") hip rafter into corner fitting and nail. Then insert opposite end of hip rafter into 3 way crown fitting and nail. Insert one end of another hip rafter into same 3 way fitting and nail. Then insert the opposite end into corner fitting and nail.
- Insert one end of center spreader into the assembled 3 way crown fitting and nail.
- Insert one end of side rafter (orange 7'7") into side tee fitting and nail. Insert opposite end into the slide fitting on center spreader and nail. Repeat on opposite side.
- Repeat steps 3 and 4 to complete remaining end of frame.
- Place canopy over frame and pull tight. Secure canopy to frame with buckle straps, tightening corner buckles first.
- 8. Raise one side of canopy, insert leg pipes (black 7'8") into the corner and tee fittings and nail.
- 9. Raise opposite side of the canopy and install remaining legs.
- The canopy and frame can now be tied down. Caution, tie down only at corner or tee fittings. Do not tie to spreader pipe as they may bend.
